### Sin and submission

#### Adam vs Satan

**Gen 1:26 (ESV)** - Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

**Luk 4:5-6 (ESV)** - <sup>5</sup> And the devil took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, <sup>6</sup> and said to him, "To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will.

#### Romans 6 - Submitting to Sin

**Rom 6:12-19 (ESV)** - <sup>12</sup> Let not **sin**, therefore, reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. <sup>13</sup> Do not present your members to **sin** as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. <sup>14</sup> For **sin** will have no **dominion** over you, since you are not under law but under grace. <sup>15</sup> What then? Are we to **sin** because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! <sup>16</sup> Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of **sin**, which leads to death, or of

obedience, which leads to righteousness? <sup>17</sup> But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, <sup>18</sup> and, having been set free from **sin**, have become slaves of righteousness. <sup>19</sup> I am speaking in human terms, because of your natural limitations. For just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness leading to **more lawlessness**, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness leading to sanctification.

**Rom 7:11 (ESV)** - For sin, seizing an opportunity through the commandment, deceived me and through it killed me.

**Eph 6:12 (TLB)** - For we are not fighting against people made of flesh and blood, but against persons without bodies...

## Temptations of Jesus

**Luke 4:1-13 (ESV)** - <sup>1</sup> And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness <sup>2</sup> for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And he ate nothing during those days. And when they were ended, he was hungry.

<sup>3</sup> The devil said to him, “If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.” <sup>4</sup> And Jesus answered him, “It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone.”

<sup>5</sup> And the devil took him up and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, <sup>6</sup> and said to him, “To you I will give all this authority and their glory, for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I will. <sup>7</sup> If you, then, will worship me, it will all be yours.” <sup>8</sup> And Jesus answered him, “It is written, “You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.”

<sup>9</sup> And he took him to Jerusalem and set him on the pinnacle of the temple and said to him, “If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here, <sup>10</sup> for it is written, “He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you,’ <sup>11</sup> and “On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.” <sup>12</sup> And Jesus answered him, “It is said, You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.” <sup>13</sup> And when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from him until an opportune time.

## Holy Soul Ties

**Gen 2:24 (ESV)** - "Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh."

**1 Sam 18:1 (ESV)** - "As soon as he had finished speaking to Saul, the soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Johnathan loved him as his own soul."

## Unholy Soul Ties

**Mat 16:21-23 (ESV)** - <sup>21</sup> From that time Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised. <sup>22</sup> And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, "Far be it from you, Lord! This shall never happen to you." <sup>23</sup> But he turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance to me. For you are not setting your mind on the things of God, but on the things of man."

# Legal Right #2b: Sexual Sin Unholy Soul Tie

**Act 15:28-29 (NIV) (Jerusalem Council)** - <sup>28</sup> It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements: <sup>29</sup> You are to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, from blood, from the meat of strangled animals and from sexual immorality. You will do well to avoid these things. Farewell.

**1 Tim 1:8-10 (NIV)** - <sup>8</sup> We know that the law is good if one uses it properly. <sup>9</sup> We also know that the law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious, for those who kill their fathers or mothers, for murderers, <sup>10</sup> for the sexually immoral, for those practicing homosexuality, for slave traders and liars and perjurers—and for whatever else is contrary to the sound doctrine

**1 Cor 6:16 (ESV)** - "Or do you not know that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For it is written, 'The two will become one flesh.'"
